IMPORTANT INFO

- Be sure to purchase the correct screws for your installation surface.

INSTALL INSTRUCTIONS:

Decorative Hardware

- Determine the position for the shutter by matching up the top and bottom of the shutter with the window and mark its position.
- Mark the shutter where you will fasten it to your installation surface. (If installing larger shutters fasten on the right a left hand side in the center of the shutter.)
- 3. Using a 1/8" bit drill pilot holes where you marked the shutter.
- 4. Using a level set the shutter in place and fasten using the correct screws for your installation surface. Be sure no to over-tighten the screws.
